

# CFK EDUCATION INITIATIVES FACT SHEET | APRIL 19, 2021

- Kibera residents live on less than \$2 a day with 80% of the youth between ages 15-25 being unemployed
- Over the past 15 years, CFK's 4 educational programs have helped to increase school attendance from 15% to 90%.

### THE ANGAZA PROJECT

- A scholarship that covers more than school fees, working with parents to create a positive learning environment.
- The scholarship has provided over 3,200 scholarships with a 100% of the graduating class in 2019 pursuing higher education.

### THE BEST SCHOOLS INITIATIVE

- A program that researches the outlying factors impacting student attendance and success at informal schools.
- BSI has directly impacted over 4,740 students, providing more than 26,000 nutritious school lunches and a reading library to over 500 kids.

### **ENTREPRENEURSHIP & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

- Teaches the youth financial literacy, computer training and connections to savings and loan associations.
- Around 50 people have gained full employment because of this program and over 600 youths are currently being trained.

### SPORTS FOR DEVELOPMENT

- A program that engages kids through team-based sports, teaching them leadership and equality. As well as providing educational workshops to discuss sexual and reproductive health.
- This program has reached more than 63,000 kids.
